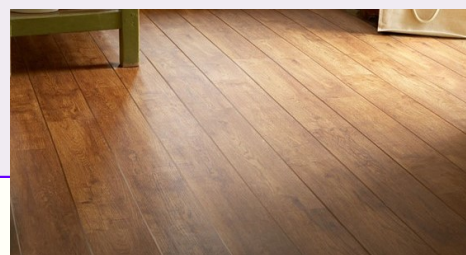


### Fire Safety

With the disaster at Grenfell Tower very much to the forefront of today's news, we are pleased to be able to say that St Cecilia had a full fire inspection in June, which we passed with flying colours. Our thanks to Nick, our fire safety officer, and Karen, for all their efforts in completing regular fire checks and records. The Fire Officer was particularly impressed by St. Cecilia's sprinkler system, installed 9 years ago. The second floor is totally protected by the sprinkler system, as is Room 3, the first floor hallway, the entrance hall and stairs. We are one of very few care homes in Dorset to have gone to these lengths to ensure the security of our residents.

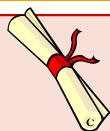
### Big Changes Underfoot!

St. Cecilia's ground floor will soon be treated to a facelift, when the carpeting will be lifted in the entrance hall, downstairs passageways, sitting and dining room. In the interests of safety, hygiene and attractiveness, the carpet will be replaced by luxury vinyl wood-effect planks. The result will be a smart, modern floor - non-slip and easily cleaned. It will be fitted by Marsden's of Broadstone. There will inevitably be some disruption to the normal routine for two or three days from 14th August, but with three fitters working together, this will be kept to a minimum.
